BY-LAW RCM-36-2011
BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT FIGHTS AND BRAWLS AND
ENSURE PEACE AND PUBLIC ORDER
ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

Notice of motion	July 11, 2011
Adoption	August 22, 2011
Promulgation	September 1, 2011

CONSIDERING sections 62, 66, 67 and 85 of the *Municipal Powers Act*, (R.S.Q., c. C-47.1)

The council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1 **Definition**

For purposes of the present by-law, ‘public property’ is defined as any street, alley, park, square or public place, including sidewalks, medians, bicycle paths, as well as the right of way of any public roadway.

SECTION 2 **Fighting**

No one may take part in a fight, brawl or any other act of physical violence on public property or on exterior land adjacent to public property.

SECTION 3 **Offense**

Anyone found to be in violation of the present by-law commits an offense and is liable to fines as follows :

- 1° for a first offense, \$500 to \$1, 000;
- 2° for a second offense, \$1,000 to \$2,000;
- 3° for any further offense, \$2,000 to \$3,000.

SECTION 4 **Coming into force**

The present by-law comes into force according to Law.
