BY-LAW RCM-36-2011 BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT FIGHTS AND BRAWLS AND ENSURE PEACE AND PUBLIC ORDER ON PUBLIC PROPERTY

Notice of motion	July 11, 2011

CONSIDERING sections 62, 66, 67 and 85 of the *Municipal Powers* Act, (R.S.Q., c. C-47.1)

The council ordains as follows:

SECTION 1 **Definition**

For purposes of the present by-law, 'public property' is defined as any street, alley, park, square or public place, including sidewalks, medians, bicycle paths, as well as the right of way of any public roadway.

SECTION 2 Fighting

No one may take part in a fight, brawl or any other act of physical violence on public property or on exterior land adjacent to public property.

SECTION 3 Offense

Anyone found to be in violation of the present by-law commits an offense and is liable to fines as follows:

- 1° for a first offense, \$500 to \$1, 000;
- 2° for a second offense, \$1,000 to \$2,000;
- 3° for any further offense, \$2,000 to \$3,000.

SECTION 4 Coming into force

The present by-law comes into force according to Law.
