**BY-LAW PERTAINING TO THE TERMS OF PUBLICATION
OF PUBLIC NOTICES OF THE CITY OF DORVAL**

Notice of motion	March 21, 2022

Meeting of the City Council of the City of Dorval, held on April 19, 2022, at 8 p.m, at the Sarto-Desnoyers Community Center, 1335 Bord-du-lac—Lakeshore. Mayor Marc Doret presiding over the meeting.

WHEREAS in accordance with section 345.1 of the *Cities and Towns Act* (CQLR, c. C-19), introduced in 2017 by Bill 122 (2017, chapter 13) a municipality may, by by-law, determine the terms governing publication of its public notices;

WHEREAS it is deemed appropriate that Council adopt a by-law to that effect;

WHEREAS a draft by-law was filed and a notice of motion was given at the Council’s regular meeting, held on March 21, 2022;

WHEREAS the preamble forms an integral part of this by-law.

THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Application

This by-law shall apply to all public notices prescribed by a provision of the *Cities and Towns Act* (CQLR c. C-19), of any other general or special law or by-law governing the City of Dorval.

This by-law takes precedence over the publication method prescribed by section 345 of *the Cities and Towns Act* (CQLR c. C-19) without exempting the City from any other publication requirement subject to a specific provision of the Act.

SECTION 2: Publication

The City’s public notices shall be published in a section provided for that effect on its website for a minimum period of fourteen (14) days from the date of its publication. Only the publication on the website is considered for the purposes of calculating the period provided for in the Act. The first day of publication shall not count.

SECTION 3: Posting and transmission by electronic means for information purposes

In addition to the terms of publication stated in section 2 and for information purposes only, the City’s public notices shall also be available:

- a) on the bulletin board of the City Hall;

- b) At the service counters of the Sarto-Desnoyers and Surrey community centres;
- c) by email to subscribers of the electronic mailing service (cyber news).

SECTION 4: Coming into force

The present by-law comes into force according to law.
